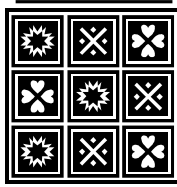
## **Class D – Quilts**

- Quilts including more than one technique should be entered in the category of the predominant technique.
- Quilt must be constructed and quilted by the person entering it, except for the “professionally quilted” and group categories.
- The term “Machine Quilted” indicated that the quilting was done on a home sewing machine or a mid-arm or long-arm machine, by either the person entering the quilt or by someone who is not being paid to do the quilting (not limited to one person).
- “Professionally Quilted” indicates that the quilting was done by someone who quilts for hire.
- “Professionally Quilted” category entries must list the name of the quilter.
