1. Entry deadline is 6:00 pm, Tuesday, June 15. **NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED.**
2. All animals must be entered in name of actual owner.
3. All small animals exhibited must be healthy. Any small animals that do not appear healthy will be removed. This includes those showing evidence of lice, fleas, etc.
4. Bedding will be provided by the fair. Exhibitors must furnish their own feed.
5. The fair will provide show cages for exhibiting rabbits.
6. Store all feed and supplies under the exhibit bench and behind the display paper.
7. Remove all feed and water from the cages on the morning of the show and place clean bedding in cages to keep animals clean for judging.
8. Entries should be as mature as possible.

~ PETS ~

Premiums will be awarded in each lot at the discretion of the judge.

Grand and Reserve Champions: Rosettes

1st \$4 - 2nd \$3 - 3rd \$2

1. Exhibitor must provide cages, feed, and litter for these exhibits. Pets brought on the fairgrounds must be on a leash or in a cage. If the pet is too large for a cage, the pet may be placed in a pen in the east side of the small animal barn.
2. The only time the pet is to leave the pen or cage is during the showing and when the pet needs to attend to toilet duties. It must be leashed and led from the north door of the small animal barn to the north end of the cattle/sheep barn. When finished with toilet duties, the pet must be led directly back and placed in a pen or cage. Anyone not following these rules will have their pet project disqualified and be expelled from the premises.

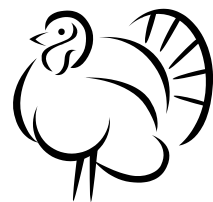

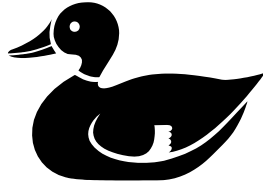

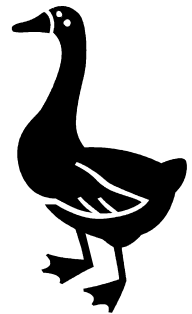

Breeding Rabbit

Market Rabbit

In some breeds weight will be determined by ideals for breed. Rabbits in a pen cannot be shown in individual lots.
